The Humane Society of Elmore County is a private, not-for-profit, humane shelter serving the citizens of Elmore County, Alabama and helping 5000 animals each year.

As a 501(c)3 organization, we rely on our fund-raising abilities and the support of all who believe in our mission to help the constant flow of homeless and unwanted pets that come to our shelter every day.
